Subject	Unit	I can statements	How you can help at home
Reading	Narrative Nonfiction	I can answer questions about a narrative nonfiction.	Read with your child for 20 minutes a night and ask questions about what they're reading. How did the character change? How they did they solve the problem? What is they did this instead?
Writing	Argument/Opinion	I can form an opinion and give reasons to back up my opinion.	When talking to your child about their opinion on things, ask them to give actual reasons. Ex: I think the Pittsburgh Steelers are the best because they have won 6 Superbowl's.
On Math	Powers of Ten	I can compare digits in whole numbers based on the base ten system.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review multiplication and division with your child. Simple math fact fluency. Ex: 6×7 72 divided by 9
Adv. Math	Geometry	I can classify polygons by their attributes.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about different types of polygons other than squares, rectangles, trapezoid. Have them point out different angels of doors and use parallel and perpendicular
Acc. Math	Division	I can divide decimals and fractions. I can find the Greatest Common Factor.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practice basic division Find the greatest common factor of 2 numbers.
Science	Magnetism	I can investigate how magnetic and nonmagnetic objects interact with a magnetic field.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore with magnets, see what it sticks to and does not, etc.
