What is the main idea of this page? What details support that? Why do you think the author included this graph/chart/map?
Writing	Informative	I can write an information essay.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have students practice writing all they know about a topic. Practice revising and editing. Make sure grammar is correct.
On Math	Decimals	I can read, write, and compare decimals to the thousandths.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Work on multiplication facts Let students add up prices at stores. Let them compare receipts. How much more is this one than that one?
Adv. Math	Line Plots	I can solve problems involving information presented in line plots.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Work on multiplication facts Give your child a set of data to plot on line plots.
Acc. Math	Ratios	I can use ratio reasoning and knowledge to problem solve	<ul style="list-style-type: none">
Science	Magnetism/ Electricity	I can investigate how magnetic and nonmagnetic objects interact with a magnetic field.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Study notes—> Test on 9/20 Starting WWI on Wednesday
