
Cost of the Trip/ Transportation

► The cost of the trip for students is \$250. The cost of the trip for parent chaperones is \$250. This includes transportation, food, and lodging.

Student arrival time is 4:30am (yes - the MORNING)

Busses will depart at 5:00am *if you are late, you will be left behind!

We will return at approximately 3:30pm on the return date.

You will receive a receipt from Ms. Ray

This will be the same process for chaperones, just with your name in the "for"

Medical Information

- ► If you are sick STAY HOME! Parents will be required to drive to Jekyll Island to pick up your child if they are sick.
- ► Fulton County Medication forms are required for all prescription medication. Prescription medication forms must be completely filled out including dosage and signature.
- Medications must be delivered to the school by a <u>PARENT</u> no later than: January 4th.
- All prescription medications must be in their original containers, and only the amount needed for the trip must be sent.
- All over-the-counter medications must also have a Fulton County Medication form, but a doctor does not have to sign.
 - Every over-the-counter medication requires its own form.
 - Suntan lotion also requires a signed form.

Chaperones

- Only male adults can go with boys, and female adults with girls.
- All chaperones will be given a group of approximately 8-10 children for whom they will be accountable for at all times.
- Chaperones will be required to bunk with the students.
- Parent chaperones will need to undergo a required background check (Details will be given. There is an additional fee).

Roswell North and Jekyll Rules

School Rules

- All Roswell North and Fulton County rules apply while on the trip.
- All Jekyll rules must be followed as well.

NO ELECTRONICS

- ► This includes cell phones, iPads, iPods, Kindle's, Tablets, Apple Watches, etc.
- Digital Cameras are allowed.

Jekyll Rules

- NO swimming
- NO flip-flops may be worn (in dorms/showers is ok)
- shoes or sandals must have a heal strap.
- NO GUM
- NO aerosol bug repellent, only lotions

- Show respect to all teachers, staff, and substitutes
- Demonstrate positive academic achievement
- Follow all Jekyll Island student rules
- Students who do not follow PBIS expectations may not participate in the Jekyll Island trip
